City Council did not request a staff report. Traffic Manager Plotnik was available to answer questions from City Council.

City Council discussion included: "Smart Street" versus traffic signal synchronization; improvement of traffic congestion, potential traffic back-up caused by vehicles traveling over the speed limit; positive impact of police presence on the speed of traffic; prior Regional Traffic Signal Synchronization Program (RTSSP) projects; and confirmation that traffic signal synchronization had been coordinated on Beach Boulevard.

Mayor Beamish invited the public to testify at 6:45 p.m. There was no testimony.

Moved by Councilmember Shaw, seconded by Councilmember Medrano, and CARRIED (4-0) TO APPROVE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR IMPERIAL HIGHWAY/SR-90 CORRIDOR REGIONAL TRAFFIC SIGNAL SYNCHRONIZATION PROJECT, CITY PROJECT NO. 3-TC-15; AWARD CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR IMPERIAL HIGHWAY/SR-90 CORRIDOR REGIONAL TRAFFIC SIGNAL SYNCHRONIZATION PROJECT TO CROSSTOWN ELECTRICAL & DATA, INC. OF IRWINDALE, CALIFORNIA IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,528,364 AND REJECT ALL OTHER BIDS; AUTHORIZE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CROSSTOWN ELECTRICAL & DATA, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,528,364; AND AUTHORIZE STAFF TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,681,200 WHICH INCLUDES A TEN PERCENT CONTINGENCY.
